HER CONFIDENCE EXPLORES THE QUIET COURAGE OF RECLAIMING WORTH AND BUILDING A NEW LIFE

Evey Hill follows one woman's journey beyond rejection and self doubt toward independence, purpose, genuine love, and confidence rooted in hope.

New York, NY, August 10, 2026 — Evey Hill explores resilience, self worth, and the courage required to begin again in *Her Confidence: The Perseverance of Dorinda Matlaboom*, an emotional women's fiction novel centered on a woman who has spent much of her life carrying the consequences of rejection and cruelty. Raised by her grandmother after being abandoned by her mother, Dorinda grows accustomed to making herself invisible in the small town of Oak Creek. Yet through sewing, she discovers a gift that gradually becomes a pathway toward independence, purpose, and a different understanding of herself.

In *Her Confidence: The Perseverance of Dorinda Matlaboom*, Dorinda's transformation unfolds gradually rather than through sudden reinvention. Her grandmother Hettie's steadfast faith and love provide an important foundation, while the arrival of Nick Tywitt, who comes to restore Dorinda's deteriorating home, introduces new possibilities. A hidden legacy from Hettie eventually gives Dorinda another reason to reconsider the future she thought was available to her.

Through family, grief, relationships, difficult choices, and creative purpose, Hill examines what happens when someone who has learned to stay small finally begins recognizing her own capabilities.

One of the story's most meaningful moments for Hill is a letter Hettie leaves Dorinda alongside a sewing machine and money quietly saved for her future. The message challenges the cruel judgments Dorinda has carried since childhood and affirms that she has always possessed beauty, strength, talent, and worth. For Hill, the scene captures the heart of *Her Confidence: The Perseverance of Dorinda Matlaboom*: painful words can shape a person's self perception for years, but they do not have to determine what comes next. Dorinda must

ultimately choose to believe in herself and build.

Hill hopes the novel reaches women who have felt unseen, overlooked, different, or convinced by painful experiences that they are somehow not enough. *Her Confidence: The Perseverance of Dorinda Matlaboom* does not present romantic love as Dorinda's rescue. Instead, she must recognize her abilities, establish independence, and learn to stand on her own before fully embracing what life offers. Her journey reflects the slow nature of rebuilding confidence while reinforcing that rejection, loss, and hardship need not become permanent definitions of identity. Hope remains possible even after years of doubt.

Evey Hill is an independent author whose heartfelt fiction explores resilience, hope, and experiences that shape women's lives. Her connection to this story is reflected in its recurring emphasis on perseverance and hope as an anchor through uncertainty. Through *Her Confidence: The Perseverance of Dorinda Matlaboom*, Hill offers more than a story about becoming confident. She presents a portrait of a woman reclaiming her voice, honoring her gifts, and refusing to remain confined by the judgments of her past, reminding readers that purpose, love, and new beginnings can still exist beyond disappointment.
